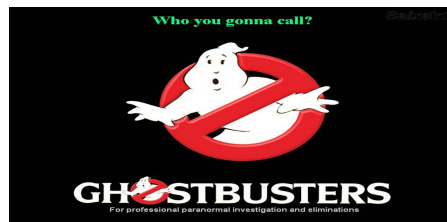


# Ghostbusters!
